### What is the LDAS survey?

Public services should be accessible.

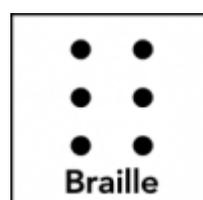

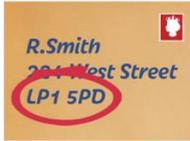
