We get politicians to meet with and talk to the Stronger Together groups about political issues.



We give training to people with learning disabilities to help them learn about politics and political issues.



We work with family, carer and support organisations and other groups across Scotland.

The groups run in Aberdeen, Ayrshire, Edinburgh, Forth Valley, Glasgow, Lanarkshire and youth groups in Dundee and Falkirk.
